### HOMESTAY POLICY

#### HOMESTAY

International students admitted in the CSF international student program must live with a host family during their studies in British Columbia. They are not allowed to live on their own. However, they can be accommodated with a trusted person designated by their family.

Advantages of Staying with a Canadian Host Family:

- a fantastic way to discover Canadian customs and culture.
- the ideal environment to improve both French and English; and
- students are hosted in a safe, stable, and welcoming environment with a private bedroom for each student and three meals a day.

The student is welcomed as a full member of the family.

The CSF works in partnership with homestay providers, and we will be there to guide and support the student during their entire stay in Canada and make sure that they experience an unforgettable educational and cultural journey with the CSF. ## REFUND POLICY

- All refund requests require a Refund Request form, fully completed and signed and submitted to the CSF's International Education Department with all the relevant and supporting documents listed in the chart below, by the relevant date listed in the chart below.
- Additional documentation may be requested to assess a refund request.
- There will be an administrative fee charged for cancellations or deferrals.
- Application fees, renewal fees and administration fees are non-refundable.
- If the CSF has collected any amounts from students that have been paid or are payable to third parties (e.g. medical insurance, assessment fees, taxes), then any available refunds will depend on the policies of the third party and whether payment of the monies is forgiven or refundable by the third party.
- Notwithstanding anything else herein, the CSF reserves the right to refuse any request for a refund, regardless of the reason for the request, if it is received after the commencement of the program.
- The program commencement date is stated on the CSF Letter of Admission ("**LOA**").

**No refunds will be granted in the following circumstances:**

- CSF terminates the student's enrollment in the program due to a breach of applicable laws, the terms of the ISA or the rules, code of conduct, or policies of the CSF or the school the student attends, by the student and/or the parent or guardian.
- If the student is unable to perform or is not performing to a reasonable academic standard.
- If there is a Change of Status after September 30<sup>th</sup>. In this case the student remains a fee-paying international student.
