### Official launch of École André-Piolat new climbing wall

(Richmond, BC) May 22, 2008. The Conseil scolaire francophone de la Colombie-Britannique (CSF) (British Columbia's Francophone School District, SD No 93) and École André-Piolat invite the media to attend the official launching of the school's new climbing wall.

An active partner in the development of British Columbia's Francophone community, the Conseil has presently in its system, and distributed across 78 communities in the province, over 4,000 students and 39 schools, of which 21 are homogeneous schools.*
