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
Consultation Questions

1. To get a "French first language" diploma (80 credits), students from grades 10 through 12 must complete:

- √ 12 credits in French 10, 11, and French Language and Culture 12
- √ 12 credits in English 10, 11, and English Language Arts 12
- √ 8 credits in Mathematics (4 in Mathematics 10 and 4 in Mathematics 11 or 12)
- √ 8 credits in Science (4 in Science 10 and 4 in Science 11 or 12)
- √ 8 credits in Social Studies (4 in Social Studies 10 and 4 in Social Studies 11 or 12)
- √ 4 credits in Physical Education and Health 10
- ✓ Career Life Education (4 credits), Career Life Relations (4 credits)
- ✓ Arts 10, 11, or 12 andt/or Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (total of 4 credits)
- 16 elective credits

Among elective courses, which specialized course subjects would be of the greatest interest in our community?





3. What specialized services do you consider to be essential in a Frenchlanguage secondary school?




5. What extracurricular activities (inside the school, supported by school staff) would you like to see offered to your Francophone children?

6. What physical structure would best meet the needs of high school students in your community?


- K 12 with separate wings for elementary and high schools
